Joseph Illo **Baptize Them!** (Deuteronomy 4: 32-34, 39-40, Romans 8: 14-17, Matthew 28:16-20) Today's Gospel is the conclusion of St. Matthew, in which the Lord Jesus commands us to "Baptize all peoples in the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." It is Trinity Sunday, always the Sunday after Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit reveals the greatest of all mysteries, the Triune God. We have been baptized into this community of Persons; now we must also teach, and baptize, others. Let's get to work!
