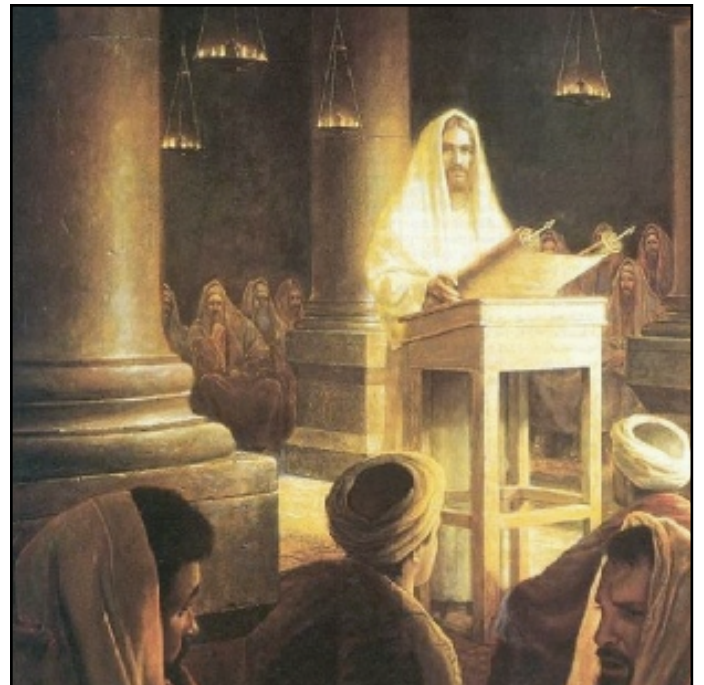

Although the project was eventually successful, the condition of the pipes under our beloved church, school & rectory were a stark reminder that old buildings need considerable TLC and the occasional emergency repair. The school plumbing was laid down in 1931 and has held up wonderfully, but as they near their 90th anniversary of continual use, we are reminded that they too need our attention.
