July 13, 1917 This
Thursday marks the
100th anniversary of the
third apparition of Our
Ladyat Fatima. Pope John
Paul II wrote that Our
Lady summed up the
whole twentieth century

in this July apparition. She warned that unless we turned to God in prayer and penance, another greater war would follow World War I. She prophesied that Russia would be overrun by atheistic Communism and spread its errors throughout the world, provoking wars and persecutions (the wars of the 20th century killed over 110 million people, and more martyrs died for Christ in the 20th Century than all the previous centuries combined). She said that entire nations would be annihilated and the Holy Father would suffer much (in fact John Paul II was nearly assassinated on Her feast day, May 13, 1981). But it was the vision of Hell that moved the three shepherd children most. Lucia described it this way: "we saw, as it were, a sea of fire. Plunged in this fire were demons and souls in human form, like transparent burning embers ... amid shrieks and groans of pain and despair, which horrified us and made us tremble with fear. The demons could be distinguished by their terrifying and repellent likeness to frightful and unknown animals, black and transparent

like burning coals. Terrified, we looked up at Our Lady, who said to us, so kindly and so sadly: You have seen Hell, where the souls of poor sinners go. To save them, God wishes to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart. If what I say to you is done, many souls will be saved and there will be peace."

Receiving at the Rail To help those who might go to Hell, we must pray deeply and offer whatever penances God sends us. I would like to invite all of you to begin receiving Our Lord at the altar rail as a concrete sign of our deeper prayer.

Waiting for Him, kneeling if possible, at

the altar rail lifts our minds to God in a beautiful fashion. Let us be a holy and devout parish, dedicated to bringing Jesus to our City with Our Lady Star of the Sea. To the right is the



new icon we had painted for our parish recently by Pavel Tikhomorov.


