Farewell to our seminarians. I write from Papua New Guinea, where I'm giving a retreat to the Missionaries of Charity sisters. I've asked them to pray especially our four men entering the

seminary next month. Don't miss our farewell party for **Brendon, David, Marko,** and **Jerick** on Aug 11 at 6pm in the auditorium.

Connectivity. When I arrived at this remote mission station last week, the first thing I asked sister superior for was internet access. But here on this South Pacific Island, I've found another kind of "connectivity." During my morning walks every single person I pass looks at me with a big smile. We say hello to each other. We "connect," even without the internet! I don't have to lower my eyes when approaching a passerby, or stare at my cellphone, or protect myself with earbuds. I am free to look at, and to speak with, perfect strangers! When I was a kid I used to say hello to people on the street, but now even grown-ups are forbidden to "talk to strangers." This isolation leads to a terrible loneliness, and to serious depression for many. A few years ago a young man jumped off the Golden Gate Bridge. The last entry in his diary was "I'm going to walk to the bridge. If one person smiles at me on the way, I will not

jump." Suicide is now the second leading cause of mortality among adolescents and young adults in the United States. But here in Port Moresby, everyone smiled at me on the street this morning. I felt about as far from lonely as I have been in a long time. Don't let the big companies tell you that "connectivity" requires an internet access point. We only need to relearn how to smile at each other. I want to take a bit of the connectivity I've found in these Islands back to San Francisco with me!


