If this will be the first of your Five First Saturdays, may God allow you to finish the next four! One hundred years ago Our Lady at Fatima asked us to keep the First Five Saturdays for peace in the world and the salvation of souls. The world had problems in 1917, but arguably it has more problems now, and needs more prayer.

The Pornography Epidemic One of the "new" problems we face is dehumanizing and addictive pornography. We priests have been hearing it for years in the confessional, but in the last ten years we hear it so much more and, heartbreakingly, even from children. Parents, you must know that if you give your child a smart phone, you are giving your child access to a whole menu of deadly toxins. We cannot expect them to carry this burden! It is hard enough for a fully-mature, battle-tested adult to handle the sophisticated techniques developed by the porn industry. How do we expect our

children have the wisdom and will power needed to defend themselves? When I was in Eastern Russia 20 years ago a common danger in the streets was open manholes. Thieves would steal the covers, leaving gaping pits open to the city's sewer system. In badly-lit streets, people would often walk into them at night, bruising and scraping themselves as they fell. Many would develop infections from contact with the filth in these sewers. Some of them would lose a limb or their evesight and some would die. We were told to look very carefully where we walked. Your child's phone, although wonderful a technology, is also a portal to that open sewer. The manhole covers are often missing. They can develop infections that will harm them for life. Come this Saturday at 8:30am to pray!
