Time is Prayer We are in the midst of our annual Stewardship Commitment weekends here at Star of the Sea: Time, Talent, and Treasure. Last week we planned our "Time," that is, our prayer lives, by filling out a Commitment

Form, a worksheet in which we planned how much time each day, each week, each year we would give to God in prayer.

Commitments to things like Sunday Mass, daily Mass, the rosary, regular confession, a weekly holy hour, etc., make us stronger, healthier, more beautiful people. Time spent in prayer is never wasted! If you have not planned your prayer life this year, I encourage you to fill out that worksheet, which is available at the church doors or at the office, and which registered members received in the mail. If you haven't gotten one, let me know!

**Talent is Service** Today we fill out the second of the Commitment Forms at Mass—what Talent God has given us that we will return to Him. Every one of us has gifts and talents from the good God, and those who hoard them miss much of the joy God wants for us. Life is about giving, not getting! What talent will you share with others in Christian service this year? The "Big Brother" ads around San Francisco show a man and a boy playing catch or running in the park with the words: "Show up. Change a life. Done." Much of the kindness we show to others is that simple. Some of the ways we can share our talent joyfully here at the parish, as writ-

ten on your commitment forms, are: Knights of Columbus for men, Mom's Group for women, Bible study, RCIA for new Catholics, teaching children's catechism, serving at the altar or singing in the choir loft, Young Adults Group, Filipino or Chinese cultural groups, Parish history committee, etc. Beyond service to others in this parish, there is your circle of friends, your family, your workplace or school. How can you share a bit of your energy and love with those around you? Take the time, commit yourself to a bit of service to others, and see how God will bless you! We will fill out these Commitment Forms at all Masses this weekend.

**Communion at the Rail** I think it's no secret that Fr. John and I encourage you to receive communion kneeling, and on the tongue, if possible. We think this is the best way to receive our Divine Lord. Even though most Catholics in America receive standing in line, we think coming to the rail gives us better recollection before we communicate with God. Coming to the rail all together is like all of God's children coming to the table and waiting with great love to be served by our Mama and Papa. Having said that, however, I want to assure you that everyone has the right to receive standing or kneeling, on the tongue or on the hand. If you come to the rail, you can stand or kneel, receive on the tongue or on the hand. You are welcome to come up in the center aisle in line too, and the priests will serve you after we finish with the rail.


