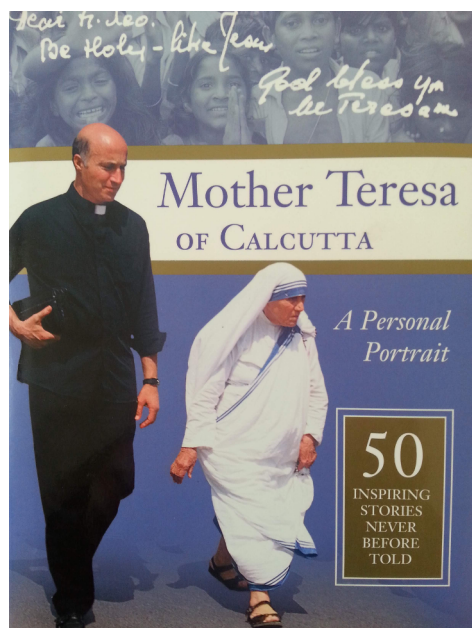

The Sunday Scriptures

by Fr. Joseph Illo **Peace be with You** (Acts 2: 1-11, Galatians 5:16-25 John 15:26-27: 16:12-15) St. John's version of Pentecost (in the Gospel today) happens on Easter night. Jesus comes through the locked doors and breathes the Holy Spirit into the disciples. "Peace be with you" he says. Isn't "a peace the world cannot give" the first fruit of the Holy Spirit? God sends that peace into each other when we say "peace be with you" at Mass, and to the priest "and with your spirit." Let us be people of deep peace, breathing it into others by our serene joy.
