My Father Last week I spent some time with my earthly father during our annual family reunion in Pennsylvania. Dad served in the US Army during World War II, arriving at age 18 in Manila to work at General Douglas

MacArthur's headquarters. Dad once gave



me a piece of Japanese occupation currency, which hangs above my desk to remind me of the cost at which these men obtained the freedom and order we now enjoy. Fifteen years later, President Kennedy had to remind Americans not to ask what our country can do for us, "but what we can do for our country." Even in 1961, the prosperity won by the men and women of the "Greatest Generation" were tempting Americans to complacency. Now, 70 years after my father fought in Manila, we are much further down the road of social decline.

The core problem in America today is fatherlessness. Twenty years ago David Blankenhorn pointed out in Fatherless America that never in American history have so many men abandoned their families. Without a father's strong and loving hand, many children will not mature. The infantile rage so embarrassingly obvious in public discussions, the adolescent violence increasingly manifest in our schools, the "failure to launch" so prevalent in the lives of adults are the inevitable result when fathers fail to form their children. God Our Father Christianity describes God as a "father," not as a mother. Mothers rarely fail us. When fathers fail us, God as father is there for us. We can return to right religion. We can pray to God as Father—in the rosary, at Mass, in adoration. Our Father, who art in

Ordination of Bishop Christian

Tuesday, June 5th San Francisco Archbishop Salvatore Cordileone ordain Bishop Robert Christian as Francisco's 18th auxiliary bishop. Numerous Star of the Sea parishioners, staff and clergy attended the event and welcomed Bishop Christian into his new role.
