**Parish School of Religion** We have a parish grammar school (scholarships are still available!), and we have a parish school of religion ("PSR") for those who attend public school. We used to call PSR "CCD" or "faith formation." I want to express my deepest appreciation to **Lorna and Bud Feria**, pillars of our parish, who have coordinated our catechism program for 25 years. Now that we have so many priests, I'm going to have Fr. Mark Taheny coordinate the

program. All classes will be taught by priests, with some help from some sisters and lay volunteers. To allow our priests to teach, the weekly class will be on Saturday morning instead of Sunday morning. This will also allow students to participate in off-campus events, such as the Rosary Rally and the Walk for Life. Charitable service will include helping the sisters feed the homeless, serving the Mass, and singing in the choir. Some Catholic school families actually supplement their education by enrolling their children in PSR, which has many hands-on activities. We will be taking registrations for PSR this year from mid-August. You can do early bird registration by calling the office and leaving a message for Fr. Mark. **July 4** I wish all of you a blessed and happy Fourth of July. God bless America!

## Archbishop Visits Star

It was a great privilege to have Archbishop Salvatore J. Cordileone visit Star of the Sea as he presided over Vespers on Friday, June 22nd.

Over 100 people attended Friday's Vespers as Archbishop Cordileone spoke of the history of Religious Freedom Week and celebrated the Feast of Saints Thomas Moore & John Fisher. These two saints were martyred under King Henry IIX in 1535 for standing up for the sanctity of marriage and the freedom of the Church. Archbishop Cordileone stated very clearly that even though we live in a safe and mostly tolerant society, the Church faces challenges to her freedom to serve in health care, child welfare services, and education. While we seek to be faithful to Christ by serving our neighbors, ignoring conscience cannot be the condition placed on people of faith in public service.
