Whatever Happened to Holy Cross Parish? I was reading a bit of San Francisco history the other day and discovered why the Buddhist temple on Eddy at Divisadero looks like a Catholic

church. It turns out that the lovely neo-classical towers once belonged to Holy Cross Parish, of which our own parish was a mission until 1894. Holy Cross parish closed after the 1989 earthquake and was eventually sold to the Buddhists, who have bravely kept its original and lovely façade. You can still read the original inscription in Latin over the main entrance, *Domus Dei sub titulo Sanctae Crucis* ("the House of God under the title Holy Cross"). The building is still there, but the people are dispersed. Our job, fellow parishioners, is to gather the scattered tribes to the altar at 8th and Geary. **SOS, at 125** the only existing history of our parish, written by St. Mary Dorothea Quinn in 1955, begins thus: "In 1886 Star of the Sea Parish was a lonely area of drifting sand dunes and sagebrush, and the only street that pierced the billows of salty fog that rolled over the hills from the Pacific Ocean was Point Lobos Avenue, the present Geary Street." In 1894 our parish became independent of Holy Cross, which makes us 125 years old this year. That's why our logo has "Stella Maris 1894" on it, and why I'd like to mark this anniversary year with some celebrations and some improvements. The first improvement is to publish a proper history with lots of archival photographs.

Carmel Tickler, who had served as operations manager for the parish from 1990 to 2015, hopes to have a beautifully bound volume by our Gala anniversary banquet on **October 19**. We are raising money for some capital improvements to our parish and school as well. The top seven are as follows: 1) Paint church interior 2) Upgrade school bathrooms 3) Touch up peeling gym interior 4) Regild five gold crosses on church towers and cornices 5) Repair sagging steps at church front 6) Install wheelchair ramp from Geary entrance 7) Provide 10-20 weekday parking spots. **Call for Pictures** Do you have historic photographs of our community that Carmel

could scan for the history? Pictures of famous alumni at our school (Gracie Allen, for instance) or milestones in our history (Pope John Paul's

visit, for instance)? **Call for Gifts** We would like to raise \$500,000, and already have about \$100,000 in the bank. We will be painting a "giving tree" mural with names of donors on the church wall opposite the school, so don't miss an opportunity to be a part of this historic year. *Fr. 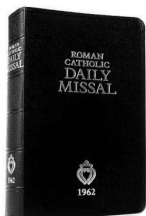

Get A Tax Break!

If you are 70 1/2 or older, you can transfer up to \$100,000 from your IRA to charity tax-free, which counts as your required minimum distribution (RMD) but isn't added to your adjusted gross income. You cannot make a tax-free transfer from your 401(k) to charity, but you can roll over money from your 401(k) to an IRA and then transfer the RMD to charity.

The Sunday Scriptures

by Fr. Joseph Illo **Into the Deep** (Isaiah 6: 1-2A, 3-8; 1 Corinthians 15: 1-11; Luke 5: 1-11)

The Lord tells Peter and Andrew to “put out into the deep” and lower your nets for a catch. They haul in such a quantity of fish as to almost sink the boat. Some would say the Catholic boat is sinking, with all the clergy scandals, weak leadership, and dwindling Mass attendance. But I would say there are plenty of fish in the sea. We just haven’t put out into the deep. Our Catholicism is shallow. To go deep, go before the Blessed Sacrament an hour a week. The fish will fight to get into your net.

Thank you to all of the parents and students who attended our Catholic Schools Week Mass and Open House. A special thank you to all of our teachers who worked so diligently to make their classrooms and our hallways look tremendous and to our parent volunteers for their warm hospitality. Attending Open Houses,

Back to School Nights, Parent-Teacher conferences and other school events, such as our Talent Show on Thursday, V.I.P. Day on Friday, and the Stella Maris Crab Feed on the 23rd, are sometimes difficult for parents to attend. They are time consuming but they are also important to your child's education for a few reasons.

First, it is important to get to know your child's teacher. Students spend about seven hours each day at school, not counting sports practice, after school enrichment programs and extended care. Teachers have a positive influence on our students and it is important to get to know all of the important people in the lives of our children.

Second, attending school events reinforces positive parent-teacher relationships. Parental involvement is supremely important in the education of children but success is also dependent on us all working together toward a common goal. When parents attend these events, they send a message to their child's teacher that

they are serious about the role that they play in their child's education. It also makes it that much easier for the teacher to initiate future conversations with parents since it has already been established that you are both on the same page, working toward the success of your child.

Third, school events allow parents to see the resources of the school and classrooms. Not all schools are created equal. Every school has problems and parents can play a major role in solving them. But we cannot solve problems that we are not aware of. In the same way, if parents are not aware of the resources of the school, then they will not know what is available to help their child become successful.

Fourth, parent involvement makes the school better. There has always been an interrelationship between the success of a school and the number of parents involved. Not only does it help the child succeed, but it also helps keep us, the teachers and administrators, accountable because it builds positive two-way relationships.

Lastly, it sends a great message to your child. It says, "not only do I want you to succeed; I am willing to be an active participant in the process of your success." Of course, attending an Open House or the Talent Show alone would not be enough to continuously convey this message but it is a positive start. Your sacrifice of time and effort in your children is NEVER in vain. I honor each parent who actively participates in the life of Star of the Sea School. It definitely makes it easier for us to do what we do. Thank you.
