**Star of the Sea Classical School** Our wonderful school, founded by the holy Sisters of St. Joseph from Ireland, has been educating children for 110 years. This year we are becoming a Classical School, which is vital to its long-term flourishing. In addition to a new curriculum, we are re-

building the indispensable connection between parish and school that has atrophied over the years. Through these improvements, our school, as an eminent ministry of the parish, will continue to shine as a light of Catholic truth and beauty in this part of the City for years to come. Lamentably, a persistent negativity among some families in the school has led to a drop in enrollment. Some are afraid the school will close.

**Our school will be open next year.** In fact interest in our school is on the rise among many homeschooling families and others who are seeking a Classical Education. Our school is changing with the times, and change is hard for those who have known things only one way. But if we don't change we die. *We will change and live!* Schools experience ebb and flow in enrollment, and we are at an ebb. If we work hard and put our trust in God, this ebb will become a flow in the next few years. The Parish and Finance Councils have al-



located \$250,000 to support the school this year, and we expect to provide the same level of support next year. The number of teachers we can afford at any time depends on enrollment, and so we will have to make adjustments based on those numbers. Marketing is vital to enrollment, and our school has fallen quite behind in this area over the last two years. One of our parishioners, a program manager for schools in Marin County, has begun coordinating the efforts of our principal and school leadership to implement an effective business and marketing plan. Our newly-

established School Board is overseeing all of the components necessary to develop our school to her full potential. **You can help** by getting the word out that something new is happening at Star of the Sea: an Integrated Classical Program that will give our students the critical and independent thinking skills needed for a rapidly changing marketplace. More than that, however, a Classical Liberal Arts Education leads to a sense of wonder as we discover the beautiful order of God's creation. I encourage you to google for yourself the videos of those schools that are becoming Classical, such as St. Therese in Alhambra (CA), or Our Lady of Lourdes in Denver, or St. Jerome's in Hyattsville (MD). ## A Message from Principal Gallagher

Star of the Sea School is on a mission. That mission is to educate students in the Catholic faith as well as provide them with the knowledge and skills that will help them to live productive and happy lives.

Unlike public schools, Catholic schools receive no funding from tax dollars. All income must come from fund raising, tuition, the generosity of donors, and the parish. Fund raising efforts, therefore, are paramount to a school's fiscal health.

In addition to fund raising, we need to continue to not only market our school to families, but also to show Star of the Sea parishioners without school-age children that we are Catholic in more than name. Our students regularly volunteer at and hold food drives for the San Francisco Food Bank, helping to feed the hungry. They make regular trips to St. Anne's Home and the San Francisco VA Medical Center to visit the sick and elderly. They act as stewards of God's creation by working in habitat restoration.

The fact that Star of the Sea is very strong academically and religiously, makes a difference in the lives of the students, the parents, and parishioners. We are a good school with good values and Catholic schools remain the Church's primary means of evangelization.

In accomplishing any mission, there will be challenges and we are certainly facing our own unique set of challenges in our school. But Catholics have always risen to that challenge by devising new educational models and new ways of financing schools. Much remains to be done, but our efforts are worth it.

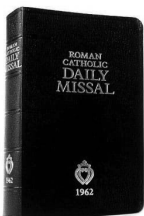
