Both retreats I'm giving this year (the other was last month in Brazil) are themed around Our Lady of Fatima, and I encourage you to read a book about Fatima during this centenary of the 1917 apparitions. Her message is truly God's word for our troubled time. Pay particular attention to

what she showed the three children this month—a vision of hell, which shocked them into offering greater prayers and penances for poor sinners. Many people are trapped in deceit and addiction, and so the evil one keeps the grace of God from reaching them. We must do our part by offering prayers and sacrifices for love of God and our fellow pilgrims on this earth. Our Lady allowed the children to see into hell during her third apparition,

but in her last one (October 1917) she allowed them to see into heaven. To get the full story, read Fr. Andrew Apostoli's fine book, Fatima for Today.

George Weigel "The Courage to be Catholic"




