The First Saturdays Devotion. One hundred years ago Our Lady of Fatima asked the three shepherd children to promote the "First Saturdays." For five consecutive first Saturdays attend Holy Mass, make a good confession, pray the rosary, and meditate on the mysteries for 15 minutes. If people do this, she said, war would be averted and many souls would be saved. Because few prayed as she asked, WWII was not averted, but many evils were avoided through this devotion. In our town time, even greater evils threaten us. At the moment, North Korea is a threat, but the destruction of marriage and family life, the porn epidemic, abortion, and other types of social collapse are the real threat. To obtain peace, let us practice the First Saturdays with dedication!

September 2, either at the 8:30am or 4:30pm Masses. Before both these Masses we pray the rosary and provide a priest for confessions. In addition, on September 13 Fr. Kevin Kennedy, a noted Fatima scholar, will speak in the church at 6pm. I heard his talk at St. Brenden's earlier this year, and it went straight to my heart. Welcome dear Fr. Kennedy! Finally, Our Lady told the children at Fatima that more souls are lost through impurity than other sins. In our time, the porn epidemic is damaging so many. I will address this topic next week.
