Extraordinary Form: First Sunday of Advent (p137 in Black Missal)



Advent Happy New Year as we enter the First Sunday of Advent today! The readings and prayers in this first stage of Advent (until December 17) focuses us on Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. Let's not only pre-

pare for December 25 but for the day of our death or the end of the world, whichever comes first. The best way to prepare for the End is to be at Mass. Wouldn't that be the perfect place either to die or to see the Lord coming on the clouds of heaven in the Parousia? Where else would you want to be as the skies dissolve in fire and the planet shake itself to dust? I want to be at Mass when all this happens, don't vou? Before I lived in San Francisco I used to think, as I drove into the city on the Bay Bridge, what if the Big One hits while I'm visiting the city today? The Big One will certainly hit someday. and we prepare for it best by attending now to the things of God, that is, the Holy Mass. **December 8** is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, the patronal feast of our nation (and so America's largest basilica is that of the Immaculate Conception in Washington). You have three Mass choices on this Holy Day of Obligation this Friday: 7:30am in Latin, noon in English, and (what I recommend) a Solemn High Mass at 6:30pm with three priests. Let us worship God rightly by honoring His Holy Mother as we commemorate her Immaculate Conception this Friday. December 9 is the day we consecrate our

beloved State of California to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Inspired by a million Polish faithful who consecrated their country to Mary last month, a grassroot effort by Californians urges parishes to hold a noon Mass on December 9, the Feast of St. Juan Diego, with a rosary procession to the ocean, if possible. We thus consecrate our very shores, our country, from coast to coast, to God. Join us on Saturday at noon! December 12 is Our Lady of Guadalupe. Mass is at 6:30pm, with Mexican dinner following. December 4 is my birthday! I'm 56. Please pray for this old priest! Fr. Joseph Illo
