Extraordinary Form: Second Sunday of Advent (p143 in Black Missal)



Comfort Today's readings echo the first lines of Handel's Messiah, or rather the great German composer echoed Isaiah 40 in his masterwork. "Comfort, speak comfort to my people," we hear on this Second Sunday of

Advent. "Speak tenderly to my daughter, that her guilt has been expiated, and her service is at an end." The Catholic Church did not invent guilt. We labor under its crushing burden from the time we can tell right from wrong. It doesn't help to pretend there is no difference between good and evil, for Mother Nature is not mocked. There is a right way to do things and there is a wrong way. Often have we mistakenly chosen the wrong way, and we feel very badly about it. What will bring comfort to our tortured hearts? "A Voice Cries Out... prepare a way for the Lord." Building this royal highway for God, that He may travel from heaven right into our hearts, comforts our hearts: Making straight that which is crooked, filling in the terrible valleys (dark holes) in our hearts, and leveling the mountains of our towering arrogance. St. John the Baptist emerges from the Dead Sea Wastes in today's Gospel, calling Jerusalem to repentance. They flocked to the River Jordan as they acknowledged their sins. Penance Advent is not just a shopping season. It is a season of penance, cleaning out our souls to make room for the child whose parents found no welcome in Bethlehem. I suggest three acts of penance. Choose one. First, canon law

stipulates that all Catholics do some form of penance every Friday. We would be a better people if we complied with this law. Give up a meal or part of a meal on Fridays. Give up TV or internet surfing. Sacrifice something every Friday, beginning now. **Second**, make a good confession before Christmas. **Third**, give some of your time to help someone. I recommend joining our Street Evangelization folks every other Sunday after the 9:30 Mass at the Clement Street Farmer's Market. The people on our streets need God, and they need us to witness to Him. Call the office for details.
