**Welcome Fr. Cameron Faller** We now have two "Camerons" in our parish. We have *seminarian* Cameron Pollette, who grew up six blocks from our parish, converted to Catholicism while at UCal Davis, and


will be ordained to the priesthood in two years. And now we have *Father* Cameron Faller, who grew up six miles from our parish (in Marin County) and moved into the rectory last week. He will serve as the Archbishop's Secretary and Vocations Director while residing at Star of the Sea. His duties will occupy much of his time and presence elsewhere, but we hope to see at least a bit of him at parish Masses and events. We also welcome his parents, **Joe and Bonnie Faller**, who have attended our Masses occasionally even before their son moved in, but now will perhaps be seen a bit more frequently. Thank you, Mom and Dad, for giving *two* priests to the Church (Fr. Cameron's brother, Kyle, was ordained on May 11).

**Witness to Love** "Love Wins" in giant letters adorns a store window not far from here. It certainly does, but what is "Love?" Is it doing whatever we want? If so, "Love" doesn't make us very happy, because never in history have people been granted more "choices" (legal, technological and economic *free choices*), but never in our history has "death by despair" been higher. Has anybody noticed that the suicide rate has increased in direct proportion to the increase in "free choice?" The inner child in us, if given whatever we want, ends up



quite spoiled, and unhappy. In fact, a child deprived of *any* discipline or guidance will end up destroying his or her own life. True Love Wins in the end, because God loves us, but it is crucial to know what "Love" is. Classic Christian philosophy (as articulated by St. Thomas Aquinas) defines love as a *decision* to seek the highest Good for the beloved. The Good God teaches us what is good or bad in Sacred Scripture (the Ten Commandments and the Beatitudes, for instance) and the teachings of His Church. Marriage is the highest earthly good, because it delivers the love of God *sacramentally* in our world. Have you noticed that few people manage to remain in married these days, and fewer young people even attempt marriage? The very idea of "marriage" has lost its essential definition. We are sadly confused, and even de-

ceived. Our parish, however, has been using a Marriage Preparation program called "Witness to Love," which was developed by a married couple from New Orleans, **Ryan and Mary-Rose Verret**. They will be staying at our parish next week, with their five children, to give presentations to the Archdiocese and to the Napa Institute. I'll speak more on their visit in next week's bulletin.
