A Mosaic of our Parish

Last Monday I saw a young lady at the noon Mass whom I've never seen at daily Mass. "Thanks for coming to daily Mass," I said. She replied with a smile,

"The yellow form on my refrigerator reminded me!" She was referring to the Stewardship Commitment forms that 365 of us filled out a few Sundays ago. This year we focused on Stewardship of Time, meaning the time each week we commit to prayer. On the weekend of October 19 & 20, we all spent five minutes after the homily planning our prayer lives on a white and yellow duplicate form. We kept the yellow forms "for our refrigerators," and we placed the white forms in the offertory baskets. About 70% of us made our commitment to prayer this year, which is a quantum leap from the 18% who filled out the forms last year. This year I didn't ask you to sign your name on the form, which probably had something to do with the huge participation rate. But even though no one identified themselves on these forms, I loved reading your thoughts and aspirations. It took me an hour to read through each of your 365 commitments, which seemed to me a mosaic of souls. My pastor's heart was stirred to see the spiritual health of our parish in detailed and living color. Many revealed a disarming honesty, and all of them (except one) showed a real desire for holiness. Here is what some wrote (all anonymous, of course): "I commit myself to refrain from complaining." "I will make the sign of the cross in public." "I want to join the Seven Sisters Apostolate." "I cannot go to confession because I am excommunicated, but I commit to Mass and ado-

ration." By far the most frequent commitment was to pray before and after meals, which indicates many of us foodies in San Francisco do not currently pray at meals, but only needed to be encouraged. The second most frequent was to pray for the Holy Souls in Purgatory, and then prayer for vocations. We did receive one negative response, the only one out of 365 positive responses. Beside the box, "Attend Mass Every Sunday," was written "against my will." He or she wrote dismissive comments, such as beside the "Read the Bible" line was written "why?" I appreciate this person's honesty and pray for his or her happiness. Let us be realistic that hundreds of thousands of people in our city want nothing to do with God, but let us thank Him that here at Star of the Sea we have at least 364 people who long and thirst for Him.

Our Anniversary Gala Over 230 happy folks gave thanks to God last Saturday at our wonderful Anniversary Gala Mass and Banquet. Our parish is 125 years old, but just getting started! We will not cease to believe and to proclaim that **Jesus Christ is Lord!** We are all His missionary disciples. May His Kingdom come, so that all may live in peace and joy! *Fr. Joseph Illo*
