The Assumption As she prayed the rosary with us, my mother would announce the Fourth Glorious Mystery as "The Assumption of Mary, Body and Soul, into Heaven." What must it have looked like, this rising of a human body into the sky? At each of the Fatima apparitions, Lucia described Our Lady's leave-taking slightly up in her head with lids half closed. The skin of her face had sunken, her breathing had become the body's intense attempt to force a little air into her collapsing lungs. A violent death rattle was upon her. She labored through the darkness, but at midnight Life arrived. Mariella describes how her mother fell asleep in the Lord: "A few minutes before she died, my mother suddenly turned her face with energy and looked up (as when someone calls you and you turn your



Magnifying God Today's Gospel includes Our Lady's Magnificat. Mary's soul *magnifies* God. "The glory of God is man fully alive" wrote the holy bishop Irenaeus in 285AD. No person was more "fully alive" than the Mother of God, and because of her spotless vitality, at the end of her earthly pilgrimage she was immediately taken up,



pancreatic cancer, Maria was given only a few weeks to live. Mariella asked me to hear her mother's confession and administer the Last Rites, which Maria received with joy. Within a few days she entered her final agony, a struggle with death that no palliative drugs can eliminate. Three days before she died, Maria could no longer assimilate food and became non-responsive. I gave her the Last Rites again five hours before the


end, and the war between life and death was

It seemed as if a hand was gently uncovering the body and soul, into heaven. We must pray with face of her youth. My mom looked healthy and young; her skin was flawless. Her cheeks, which had been sunken in, filled out and she was breathing normally again, with no signs of pain. Her face looked peaceful as she turned younger right in front of our eyes. We thought that she begin walking around the room. Then she closed her eyes and fell asleep...she had died." She had not, in fact, "died," but she had been taken back to God. The Sunday Scriptures

By Fr. Joseph Illo (Rv 11:19a; 12:1-6a, 10ab; 1 Cor 15:20-27; Lk 1:39-56. **The Assumption** The Gospel for today's feast includes both the Second Joyful Mystery, the Visitation, and the great canticle of the New Testament, the Magnificat of Our Lady. But let me point you back to the first reading, from Revelation 12: "A great sign appeared..." and a voice in heaven declares: "Now have salvation and power come, and the Kingdom, and the Authority of the Christ." Our Lady heralds the Kingdom, and so we stay closer to her.


