




Annual Archdiocesan Appeal

Today is the only day of the year that I show a movie at Mass, and I pray your indulgence. It is the Archbishop, actually, who asks us to watch this video during the sermon, which is a kind of

break in the divine liturgy, a time of instruction rather than pure worship. He asks us all to watch this 5-minute video so that we can appreciate the work of God beyond our own parish. Once a year the Archbishop takes up an offering to support this work, even as parishes take up an offering every week. Before deciding how much support you will give to the Archbishop this year, however, know that *we don't give to a need, but we have a need to give.* That essential principle of Christian stewardship should drive all of our giving. We have a real human need to share our blessings, to support and build up those outside of our own (relatively) small worlds. Helping build up community beyond our personal needs fills our lungs with fresh air, and fills our hearts with joy. Everyone has to decide, before God, what amount to give each year, and I've decided to give \$925 to the AAA this year. I couldn't quite make the 1% club this year, so I'm starting the "0.75% Club"! The goal has dramatically risen from \$84,000 last year to



The Archbishop visiting our school in 2014


\$123,000 this year, partly because many more are giving significant gifts to the parish throughout the year. Many hands make light work, so if you can give a full 1% of the goal (\$1230), or even 2% or 3% (some people do), go for it. If you can give 0.75% like me, or 0.10% (\$123), do it. Star of the Sea now has 1400 registered households, so if each of us gives only \$100 a year to the Archbishop, we got it licked. All funds raised above the goal come back to the parish, and I'm designating those excess funds to our school scholarship program this year. I would be very happy if every one of our 1400 households gave *something* to the Archbishop this year (last year about 500 of our 1200 households at that time participated). So go ahead: make

your pastor happy.

Lent and St. Joseph You have three days to plan your Lent, if you haven't already done so. What will you do for God to prepare for Easter? What in your life needs some Spring cleaning for the Lord (not to mention for the people you live and work with)? Please choose at least one good thing from each of these three categories: prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. You've got almsgiving taken care of (see above regarding the AAA). For fasting, how about no snacks for 40 days? For prayer, how about praying the litany and novena prayer to St. Joseph, which we started on Valentine's Day for our lovely school, that it may increase this year? You can find that novena on our website, and we pray it after every Mass until March 19. And of course, you could add a few daily Masses to your week during Lent. See you all on Wednesday for your ashes! *Fr. Joseph Illo*


