



**Month of Our Lady, Day of St. Joseph**

Today begins the lovely month of May, but May 1st is also the Feast of St. Joseph the Workman (the older title for Joseph). We named our Knights of Columbus Council after St. Joseph the Workman, and we've

entrusted our school, Stella Maris Academy, to his fatherly protection. Archbishop Joseph McGucken consecrated our adoration chapel to St. Joseph in 1959 (reconsecrated by Archbishop Salvatore Joseph in 2016), and my name is Joseph too. We have a lot for which to be grateful to St. Joseph! Most of all, we thank Joseph of Nazareth for taking Mary of Nazareth into his home, providing for her and her Son, and protecting the Holy Family until he died a holy death with Jesus and Mary by his side. Every day I renew my consecration to St. Joseph with these final words: "O Blessed St. Joseph, pray for me, that I may know the peace and joy of your holy death." With Our Lady and St. Joseph looking over us, Star of the Sea parish and school are well protected and given all the graces we need to build God's Kingdom on earth, preparing for heaven.

**Mayday Mayday Mayday!** This distress signal was first used in England in 1920 (from the French *m'aidez* or "help me") as an all-points distress signal. We could use it today for our foundering civilization! I'm putting out a mayday call to Our Lady and St. Joseph, to save California from crashing against the reefs of reality, to save our Church from sinking in the storms of secularism, and to save our poor human race from foundering in the fens of chaos. I thank so many of you for staying after daily Masses to pray the rosary,

which is our mayday signal to heaven. "Pray for us now, and at the hour of our death!" Heaven is real, but so is hell, and we desperately need help navigating the shoals of this earthly pilgrimage. Any of us could lose our faith, and take others down with us into the hell of unbelief. One of my most pious altar servers from many years ago grew up, went to the University of Steubenville, was on fire with his faith, married and had children. All seemed well until he tried to win an argument with an atheist friend who was a bit cleverer than him. Tragically, he lost his faith and took his whole family down with him. He lives in darkness now and could end up in eternal darkness. We send out the mayday signal to Mary and Joseph for him, and for so many people who have lost their bearings in the hostile atheism engulfing us.

**Walk to Mary** A good way to pray the rosary is with others, walking. How about a little pilgrimage this Saturday, May 7? I will lead our second annual Walk to Mary, three miles down Geary, to the Cathedral for the Archbishop's 10am confirmation Mass. We leave the parish at 8am, and I will lead four rosaries along the way. The "Walk to Mary" comes out of Our Lady of Good Help Shrine in Wisconsin (the only approved Marian apparition in the United States). Many of our school students will be competing in their first Track Meet at St. Ignatius Prep that day, but if you are not at the track meet, join me for a peaceful walk to the cathedral praying the rosary!
