February Weddings Many get married in the pleasant month of June, but I would say that it takes strength of character to get married in February. This month I have the privilege of solemnizing the Sacrament of Matrimony for three starry-eyed couples: Dan and

The word "matrimony," if you didn't know, means "mother-hood," [from matri-monium in Latin], which is why being open to children is essential to marriage (even if God never blesses the spouses with offspring). And being open to children is why matrimony can only be solemnized between a

The surest way to deconstruct marriage is to pretend that children are not essential to matrimony, but that matrimony is merely an agreement between adults to further their own self-interests. Certainly companionship, pleasure, financial security, and common interests are good things in

one thing that makes marriage distinct from any other human relationship is the capacity to bear and raise children in a loving environment (which we call "the family").
