
Lent's Endgame Some of you will be reading these words on the Feast of the Annunciation (Saturday) and some will be reading them on Passion Sunday (in the older

calendar) and some on the Fifth Sunday of Lent (in the newer calendar). As for me,

I'm writing them on the Feast of St. Joseph, praying to my patron for inspiration. To be a Catholic is to move from feast to feast, even in Lent, and to receive grace upon grace. Lent, indeed, is coming to its conclusion, its perfection, as we enter Passiontide and prepare for Holy Week and the Sacred Triduum, the three holiest days of the year. Four adults are preparing for baptism at the Easter Vigil, but all of us are preparing to renew our baptismal promises; that is, we are preparing for death. Baptism is death—death to this world—and new life in Christ. We are preparing to renew our resolve to "go to Jerusalem to die with Him," so that we might rise with Him. Lent's endgame is death, and resurrection. Death to sin! Let us crucify our doubts and infidelities on the Cross of Christ! We will die with Him, so as never to abandon Him. We will cling to Him, so as never to be parted from Him. We enter Passiontide today, in the older usage, so let's make these last two weeks of Lent count. Let's put our backs into it and finish the race well, so that one day we can trade in our cross for a crown.

Chrism Mass This

Thursday the Archbishop will celebrate the Mass of the Oils, known



chastity, simplicity, and obedience at this Mass, and I encourage you all to attend so that you may see the Archbishop consecrating these oils with your own eyes, Catholic Church and hear your priests renewing their sacred promises with your own ears. So that all our priests may attend the Chrism Mass with the Archbishop, and to encourage you all to attend, I've canceled the 6pm Mass this Thursday.

Stations of the Cross This Friday will be the last Stations of the Cross before Good Friday. I will use Stations taken from the meditations of St. Catherine of Siena this Friday, and next Friday (Good Friday) I will use the Stations written by the Venerable Fulton Sheen. We priests are encouraged to see how many attend our Friday Stations, and also to see many of you praying the Stations privately throughout Lent. I resolved to pray the Stations every Friday, but last Friday I

missed it so I prayed them on Tuesday of

the following week. Stations are not just

for Fridays, and I am consoled to see many people in our parish praying them on weekdays, even throughout the year. One priest described Star as a "devotional parish," and I don't think I would want it any other way. "Devotion" means "love," literally "to keep a vow." The best that could be said of a Catholic parish is that its people have resolved (have vowed) to love the Lord God with all their hearts, minds, and strength.



The Sunday Scriptures

By Fr. Joseph Illo (Ezek 37: 12-14; Rom 8: 8-11; Jn 11: 1-45) In the Flesh Our Lord raises Lazarus this Sunday; flesh that had already decayed four days was made healthy again. But Paul says in the Epistle that "those who are in the flesh cannot please God." Lazarus would die again, and his flesh would decay into dust. So let's put to death fleshly desires, and we will not fear death. In fact, in our flesh we will see Him, raised up, and we with Him.

St. John Damascene (676-749) is the last of the Greek Fathers, who Pope Leo XIII declared as doctor of the Church, and is commemorated on March 27. He wrote profoundly on the Eucharist: "For the Lord's flesh is life-giving spirit because it was conceived of the life-giving Spirit. For what is born of the Spirit is spirit.. [and] I wish to make clear its life-giving and divine power, John 6:63."
