Easter Glory, Paschal Gratitude Last week's great liturgies were really beautiful, and so well-attended by such devout and engaged parishioners and friends. It was truly a Holy Week. We ran out of Tenebrae booklets on Holy Thursday and made up another

fifty for the next day, and I had to scramble to add another fifty Stations of the Cross booklets for

Friday night! The church was as full as I've ever seen it both for the Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday night and at both the 9:30 and 11:30 Masses on Easter Sunday morning. Your faith greatly consoles us priests. We are grateful and humbled, as well, by the heartfelt cards you give us priests at Easter, and the heartwarming gifts of food. For the last five years, even though we have a full rectory, we have not needed a cook because of the loving meals provided by so many saintly parishioners. Thank you! New Catholics I'm also most grateful to God for the two men who submitted to baptism into the Catholic faith at Easter, Michael Joseph Deuel and Forrest Francis Chambliss, as well as for William, Katherine, Paula, and Sidney, who completed their sacraments and are now fully Catholic. Please keep these fine people in your particular prayers during paschaltide.

Mercy Sunday Today we welcome Fr. Cameron Faller back to Star of the Sea (he was once—all too briefly—living in our rectory,

before and during Covid). Fr. Faller will preach our Divine Mercy Mass today at 3pm. Mercy Sunday concludes the glowing Paschal Octave, eight days of breathing deeply the promise of resurrection and new life. When Our Lord expired on the Cross, he breathed out the Divine Mercy upon the whole world, pouring water and blood from his Sacred Heart onto all of us. We ourselves are merciful to the degree that we receive mercy from God, for no one gives what he does not have. To be "kind" and "tolerant" and

"non-judgemental"—virtues so often invoked in our secular culture—we must receive the Divine Mercy first. No individual, and no society, is

authentically "kind" without God's grace. The further we move from God, the less "kind" we will be to each other, and that is just what we've seen in our politics, social fabric, and individual relationships. So let's make the effort to draw closer to the Divine Mercy, to Jesus on the Cross, to Jesus resurrected and reigning, the King of Mercy. Pilgrimage to the Holy Land Tomorrow night I leave for the Holy Land with 50 pilgrims, including Deacon Albert and my old friend Fr. Mark Wagner (pastor of Presentation Parish in Stockton). We go first the Jordan, and in this peaceful Kingdom we will climb Mt. Nebo, where Moses beheld the

Mt. Nebo, where Moses beheld the Promised Land and was buried. Jordan also contains the site of Christ's baptism on the River Jordan, and the spot where Elijah lived in his cave during the troubled time of King Ahab. From Jordan we will cross into Israel, to Nazareth, Bethlehem, and Jerusalem. Catholics should journey to the Holy Land at least once in our lives; this will be my sixth pilgrimage to the land where His feet trod, and truly I come to know Jesus and His Church better with each trip. The Holy Land

is often called the "fifth gospel," and we will all pray for you as we make our way through the lands where Christ was born, lived, died, and rose.
