When an ambitious appeal goal is met in three weeks, it is essentially a vote of confidence for your pastors, for both the Archbishop and the pastor. You are saying that we are doing a good job and should keep doing what we are doing. At least that's how I take it, both for me and for the AB, so I take it we should just keep doing what we are doing!

Singing the Mass Most Catholics do not sing at Mass, but most Catholics can sing at Mass. The

Archbishop is putting some significant time and money into changing our minds about singing the Mass. He has established the Benedict XVI Institute for Sacred Music, which commissions original Mass settings, and now he has established the **Institute for**

Catholic Institute for Sacred

Music at St. Patrick's
Seminary in Menlo Park. The
director, Dr. Jennifer
Donelson, is a friend and
accomplished liturgical
musician. She will present on
sacred music here at the parish
in the Fall, but in the meantime
is directing a choir at Mater
Dolorosa Parish in South City,
and offering many short
courses on the basics of
liturgical song. It's a golden
opportunity to make the Mass
so much more reverent,

beautiful and prayerful. Many have told me how beautiful our choir has become at the 11:30 Mass. Imagine the entire church singing like that! I would like many of my parishioners to take one or more of Jennifer's courses, but in particular the five-day in-person Choral Institute at the seminary from July 17-21. There is no charge, but one must have an undergraduate degree to apply. I encourage you to take a look at all the offerings at this website:



On April 24th, we celebrate St. Fidelis of Sigmaringen. He was born Mark Rey and became a lawyer, defending the most marginalized in society and earning the name the "Poor Man's Lawyer." In every town that he traveled to, he always

visited the hospitals and churches, and prayed several hours on his knees in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. Later, he became a Capuchin and was given the name Fidelis, which means "faithful." And that he was! He was sent to preach to the Calvinists, who eventually killed him. About 15 years later, he was made a saint for his martyrdom.
