They are both with Christ now, having died with the sacraments in the hope of God's mercy. I will celebrate a sung requiem for my father here in the parish tomorrow (Monday) at 6pm. We live in the age of the Holy Spirit, and today's mystery (the Third Glorious Mystery of the Holy Rosary) reveals the Church's birth in the Upper Room, the same place where Jesus offered the First Eucharist.
