How to Receive Holy Communion Most of us



receive Holy Communion correctly, but some do not. In my considered opinion, the best way to show reverence to the King of Kings when he deigns to come into our bodies is to kneel and receive Him on the tongue, in a gesture of grateful and docile receptivity. You may receive on the hand, and if so please place your left hand over your right hand, extended flat up towards the priest, who will place the Sacred Host on your palm. You would then pick up the host with your right hand and place it carefully in your mouth. Please do not put both hands out in 'V,' or reach out to grab the Host (we are receiving Jesus, not taking Him!) Please consume the Host before leaving the altar rail. Thank you!

Two Novices We welcome two women who are discerning their call to consecrated life in a new religious institute dedicated to interceding for unborn children and their parents. Immolatia and Adriana were both Franciscan nuns who have

determined, to the best of their ability, that God has called them from the cloister to the streets to pray at ground zero in the culture war: abortion facilities. A group from our parish already prays every Thursday at the Planned Parenthood abortion center on Bush Street, along with the continuous prayer called Forty Days for Life during Lent and Advent. Both women are seeking a diocese in which they can develop their apostolate, and will be with us for a "come and see" discernment experience until September 4. You will probably see them at daily Mass and adoration.

Two Seminarians Two of our diocesan seminarians will be at all the Masses this Sunday to tell us the short version of their call to the sacred priesthood. Of course, no one is sure he has a call to the priesthood until he is actually ordained by a bishop, but these men are steaming ahead with seminary studies in good faith. I can personally vouch for both of these men, who often visit our parish for its beautiful liturgies.



Cameron Sellers was born in Seoul, South Korea, was adopted and raised in Arizona, and converted to Catholicism in college. He is a retired colonel of the US Army, having served for 34 years with combat deployments in Bosnia, Afghanistan, and Iraq. Cameron has also been

assigned to our parish this year for pastoral field work.



Kyle Laluces was born in the Philippines, worked in tech, dated during his young adult years, and volunteered much in various parishes before diving into seminary studies three years ago.
