procession down to St. Boniface, with rosary and benediction (and lunch). Blessed Feast of the Holy Rosary, this Saturday, October 7th! Our Dear Physicians I have the greatest respect for doctors and nurses. In the best of worlds, doctors and priests work together, because we are body-soul composites. I laugh every time a Filipina nurse calls me "doctor" and then corrects herself: "I'm sorry, I mean 'father.' But you know, Father, you are doctors too." Priests and physicians work together to heal the whole person, body and soul. Jesus came to save us, and the word "save" comes from the Latin word salus, or "health." Jesus

came to make us healthy, to save us from sin that causes death.

A Smalltown Doctor Healthcare used to be a vocation, but it has become a business, controlled by insurance conglomerates and government agencies. We pay the giant healthcare companies to "fix" us the way a mechanic fixes cars. I grew up in a small town in Pennsylvania that had only one doctor. 60 years ago everybody in my town went to Dr. Freeman. His office was in his big white colonial home on main street. Everybody knew Dr. Freeman, and Dr. Freeman knew just about everything about everybody. He would make house calls, with his black leather satchel, and we all trusted him with our personal welfare. The priests in our little town came and went, but Dr. Freeman, and now his son and grandson, have had the trust of my hometown for three generations. I think it is because of Dr. Freeman that I have such reverence for doctors and nurses.

The Catholic Medical Association Doctors have become less personal, and less trusted, as healthcare has "industrialized." Abortion has become "healthcare" in 1973, and now mutilation of children's sex organs has become "affirming care." In all this sad confusion, the Catholic Church, when she is at her best, still shows the true healing arts, faithful to Hippocratic Oath and the true nature of the human person. The largest fellowship of Catholic doctors and nurses is the Catholic Medical Association ("CMA"). The Archbishop praying at last year's Established in 1932, the CMA has grown by 80% since 2006 because

Catholic healthcare professionals know they need to support each other as healthcare reserves its own principles. This year's national conference, themed on "Courage," issued its position paper on "The Ideology of Gender Harms Children." Our San Francisco guild president, Dr. Stephen McCurdy (U. C. Davis Medical Center), joined 700 other doctors,

nurses, and medical students at this conference, and look forward to next year's conference in Orlando, entitled Imago Dei: Made in His Image. Male and Female He Created Them. I have been asked to serve as our local guild's chaplain (I served as founding chaplain to the Modesto guild 20 years ago), and I have been so impressed with the caliber of our quarterly meetings. We meet every three months for Saturday 8:30am Mass at Star, then a breakfast meeting with speaker in the rectory. I encourage all healthcare professionals to join our guild, and see the CMA website, www.cathmed.org. Our next meeting will be Oct 14, and the Archbishop will celebrate our annual "White Mass" Oct 20 (6pm) at Mater Dolorosa parish. All are invited to the White Mass, to honor and pray for our beloved doctors and nurses; all medical professionals would receive much support and joy in joining our local guild. Fr. Joseph Illo
