Thanksgiving October used to be my favorite month, but now I think it might be November, even though this month is generally dark and cold and rainy. But November is the month of *Thanksgiving*, and the essence of a happy life is gratitude. A thankful person is a happy

person, and a man who gives thanks always is always happy. A woman who cultivates gratitude rather than complaining over life's difficulties, and a man who smiles rather than scowls when the going gets tough, is a light to all around them. Their joy is infectious, and it comes from *giving thanks in all circumstances*, as St. Paul urges of us. Certainly the circumstances for the 53 survivors of

the Mayflower voyage in the fall of 1621 would have justified negativity and complaint. And yet they were *pilgrims*, that is, religious seekers who sought God's will with thankful hearts. God sent them 90 Native Americans of the Wampanoag tribe to befriend and support these early American Christians, and the two peoples gave thanks to God together.

All Saints and All Souls

This month is beautiful because, as a nation, we give thanks to God. It is beautiful also because we give thanks for All Saints, that shining crown of jewels encircling the brow of the King of Kings. November is the month to give thanks also for All Souls, our dear ones whom we remember in the 400 photographs under Our Lady's altar this month. I light a candle every day of November and kneel at Our Lady's altar, looking over the faces of my parents, grandparents, and all those precious lives whom God has given us over the years, and I am filled with gratitude. All together, we pilgrims are making our way to the greatest gift of all, which is eternity with the Holy Trinity, in perfect happiness. How could any adversity during our brief pilgrimage compare with the glory awaiting each of us, and all of us together? So, let us do our best to give thanks with a grateful heart to the All Holy One who has given us every good thing.

A Mass of Thanksgiving The first Thanksgiving on our shores was not in 1621, by the way. There was an even more essential act of gratitude to God on September 8, 1565, when Spanish settlers offered a Mass of Thanksgiving at what is now the city of St. Augustine, Florida. After Mass they sat down to a meal with the Native Americans, just as their protestant brethren from England would do 56 years later in what is now Massachusetts. I invite you to our annual "Mass of Thanksgiving" this Thursday at 10am, to which you are invited also to bring some food from your Thanksgiving
