
Welcome Walk for Life Pilgrims! About 85 students and faculty from four schools (in San Diego, Los Angeles, and the North Counties) are staying at the parish this weekend

to attend the Walk for Life West Coast. Welcome to Star of the Sea and San Francisco! Michael John Poirier will be providing music for the pilgrims' Mass on Sunday (8am), as well as leading a holy hour on Saturday night from 9-10pm. Our thanks to all who organized both parish and archdiocesan events for the Walk, and of course to our own Eva

Muntean and Dolores Meehan for putting on this important event for twenty years now.

A Day of Prayer I grew up near Washington, DC, attending the great March for Life, which has been an annual beacon of hope in our country since 1974. Our own Walk for Life, like the national March for Life, is *youthful*. The vast majority are teens, college students, seminarians and young priests, young religious sisters, and large families with abundant children and grandchildren. I often mistakenly call the Walk for Life "World Youth Day," since a joyful energy characterizes both experiences. But I must recall the reason for the Walk for Life, which is legalized killing of innocent children. Good will always win in the end, but we should properly mourn evil and work to correct it during our pilgrimage to heaven. The political

leadership in California, as in other wealthy states, has made abortion a kind of religion, or at least a key political rallying point. Cynically building one's political career on the destruction of unborn children and their mothers is a great evil; the wholesale corruption of people's





thinking by the abortion industry, public education, and powerful media has greatly harmed our country since 1973. While the Walk for Life overflows with joyful energy, we must also mourn the great evil of legal abortion. We must do penance to cast out these demons. Participating in the Walk for Life is a joy, but also a penance, and must be understood as such.

Walk for Life Every Week
Six or seven people from our
parish pray at the Planned
Parenthood abortion facility

twice a week (Thursdays at 6pm and Saturdays at 10am). I try to join them every Saturday morning, and I encourage you, who have walked for life this Saturday, to keep it up throughout the year. Make it a habit to pray at the place where mothers and fathers are deceived into allowing someone to kill their own children. "These demons," the Lord said, "can only be cast out by prayer and fasting." We must fast and pray here below, so that we can feast and rejoice eternally in the life of the world to come. We must do our part in witnessing to the Gospel of Life that Jesus Christ has purchased for us by his own blood. I will give the keynote address on how the Church meets the needs of all


# The Sunday Scriptures

By Fr. Joseph Illo (Jon 3: 1-5, 10; 1 Cor 7: 29-31; Mk 1: 14-20) Repent and Believe Our Lord's first words upon embarking on his public ministry were "repent and believe," apparently in that order. To believe, that is, to trust God, we must shake off the blindness of heart that comes from sin. Most people start violating the laws of God as believers, but soon enough their sins cause them to lose their faith. So, if you want to fully believe, you must go to confession, early and often.

Our prayer before the Eucharist is a time when we lean on Jesus' breast, like John did at the Last Supper, and allow his heart to speak to ours. "Cor ad cor loquitur" ("heart speaks to heart," was the episcopal motto of St. John Henry Newman). Confessions are available during the Holy Hour.



#### **EUCHARISTIC ADORATION**

We celebrate St. Polycarp, bishop and martyr on January 26 (traditional calendar). He was an Early Church Father influenced by St. Paul and an apostle of St. John. St. Polycarp then influenced St. Irenaeus who explained transubstantiation.

Pray the words of St.Polycarp: Lord, almighty God and Father ... I praise you for all things, I bless you, I glorify you through the eternal priest of heaven, Jesus Christ, your beloved Son. Through him be glory to you, together with him and the Holy Spirit, now and forever. Amen.






Dear Parishioners of Star of the Sea,




