Lent Begins Every few years Ash Wednesday lands on Valentine's Day, which is a good thing because, as Catherine de Hueck Doherty wrote, "Lent begins with desire." Valentine's Day is marketed in terms of desire for other humans, but St. Valentine died in witness to

his desire for God. As bishop Valentinus was led off to be executed, he left a little note for his flock: "Love God, from your Valentine." Lent is given us to refine our desire for creatures into a purer desire for the Creator, only in whom we can love other humans properly. For that to happen, we need to pray, fast, and give alms. But let not the means of sanctification (prayer, fasting, almsgiving) become the *end* of Lent. These three Christian practices are meant to lead us to that which our hearts desire, the Good God Himself. Where will you find your heart's desire? In silent prayer before the Eucharist, having been purified by fasting, and so readied to do good for others. Lent has begun, my dear people, so let us commit ourselves to prayer. Let us cleanse our lives, pushing food and drink and entertainment aside. And let us do good for others, making gifts of time and money for those who need

A Good Confession I daresay more confessions are heard at Star of the Sea every week than at any other parish in the

Archdiocese, and I thank both the penitents and the priests for this abundance of grace. But we can always improve how we confess our sins. We priests hear a certain amount of blaming others ("I yelled at my wife because she...."), a good amount of story -telling ("Let me tell you how it happened, Father...."), and a lot of other people's sins ("My husband yells at me,

and my kids don't listen to me, Mass on the sidewalk to begin our 40 Days something for this year's and I don't deserve any of it").

One of Lent's goals is to make a good confession, to walk away from the confessional a free and new man or woman, deep-down cleansed of all weaknesses and fears. Many don't know how to make an "integral confession," and so we priests will give some helpful tips in our homilies this Sunday. Inside this bulletin is an examination of conscience, for children on one side and for adults on the other side. You can help us priests to be more effective and more efficient in the confessional (shorter wait times!) by preparing well for your confession. And pray for us too, that we priests go to confession early and often, humbly confessing our own sins to each other.

Church Flooring and Stations On Monday we will begin restoring the church flooring to its original hardwood maple. Sunday Masses for the next three weeks will be in the gym, and daily Masses in the chapel. Stations of the Cross will be in the auditorium for the next three Fridays at 6:30pm. Please consider attending daily Mass, and Stations, as part of your Lenten renewal. I will also begin a 33-day consecration to Our Lady this Thursday to prepare for a parish consecration to the Immaculate Heart on March 25. Every day you will get an email from me with a reflection on the daily reading from Fr. Gaitley's 33 Days to Morning Glory.






