Easter Joy Christ is risen, and indeed He is risen! A warm welcome to all who are visiting our community this Easter, and also to those who don't quite make it every Sunday. Some of you may be amazed that, since you were here last Easter, we have restored the

1929 maple hardwood floor. It was a big job, moving all the hundred-year-old oak pews to the gym for Masses there during Lent, but here we are at Easter with the golden warmth of the original hardwood laid down by our ancestors five generations ago. We had removed our 18 shrine statues during the dusty refinishing work, and then they were covered for the two weeks of Passiontide, but now these many statues of Our Lady shine with

the glow of our new floor in a church bursting with white lilies. If you are a visitor, take a little stroll past these shrines, perhaps taking a brochure from one or two that catch your eye. I prepared these 18 brochures to describe the essential facts and messages of each visit of Christ's mother over the centuries, to almost every nation on earth. Truly the good news of Christ's resurrection is has gone out to the ends of the earth. A blessed and happy Easter to all of you, and thank you for coming first to the Mass of the Resurrection to celebrate this holiday.

Doubting Divine Mercy I've been sending out an email reflection every day since March 6 on Fr. Michael Gaitley's book 33 Days to Merciful Love. Next Sunday will conclude those 33 days, and many of us will make our consecration to the Divine Mercy. This consecration will be a great act

> of trust on our part. On Good Friday every one of the Apostles doubted Jesus, all deserting Him. On Easter morning the Apostles doubted Mary Magdalene's report of the Resurrection. On Easter night Thomas doubted that He had come through the locked doors of the Upper Room. We all struggle with doubt when life hurts us. We lose our nerve. On Good Friday we began the Divine Mercy Novena, prayed every day at 3pm in the church until Mercy Sunday, AKA "Doubting Thomas Sunday." On that day that the Risen Lord came again through locked doors to drown Thomas' doubts in the ocean of His mercy. I urge you to pray the chaplet of Divine Mercy, with St. Thomas, to gain God's gift of freedom from doubt. Without a Head of School doubt, He is Risen!




