be our Lenten novena? What will be this year's Springtime cleaning? Which book will we read together for our 33-Day consecration this year? In years past we've gone through Father Gaitley's 33 Days to Morning Glory (a monthlong

Consecration to Our Lady) and Fr. Calloway's Consecration to St. Joseph (a 33-day preparation for March 19). This year I've chosen another of Father Gaitley's books, 33 Days to Merciful Love, in which we prepare for consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on Divine Mercy Sunday. Every year we celebrate the Sunday after Easter, within the Octave, also called "Low Sunday," with a sung Chaplet of Mercy at 3pm, a speaker, and a Mass. This year Fr. Joseph Homick from the Contemplatives of St. Joseph will preach the Mass on Mercy Sunday (April 7), and I will lead the singing of the chaplet as usual. But get ready, because this Wednesday begins the 33-day countdown to April 7, so I encourage you to get Fr. Gaitley's book (either in paper or online) and read it along with me. Each morning I will deliver an email to your inbox (if you are registered in the parish and have given me your email-see page 3 of this bulletin to register if you need to). That daily morning mail will contain 3 minutes of reading on Fr. Gaitley's wisdom for the day, following the 33

chapters of his book. Finally, on April 7, we will celebrate the Merciful Love of Christ at Sunday Mass, and in particular at 3pm that day, the Hour of Mercy, the hour of redemption, the hour of salvation. In years past I've so enjoyed getting up a half hour early to write and send these meditations from Father Gaitley's and Father Calloway's books. I look forward to this new book, 33 Days to Merciful Love and hope you will enjoy this traditional

Parish Mission at Holy Innocents Next week I will preach a Lenten Mission at Holy Innocents Parish in Long Beach. Holy Innocents is a historic parish in the Los Angeles Archdiocese, at which Cardinal William Levada was baptized and educated. Not only a future cardinal, but a future saint received the sacraments at this parish: the Venerable Mother Maria Luisa Josefa of the Most Blessed Sacrament, foundress of the Carmelite Sisters of the Most Sacred Heart of Los Angeles, came to Long Beach in 1927 as a refugee from Mexico during the Cristero war. Just like the Carmelites at Cristo Rey Monastery on Parker Avenue and the Adoration Sisters on Ashbury street in our own city, Mother Luisa sought religious freedom. She taught catechism to the children of the parish, and two Carmelites of the order she founded still teach in the parish school. Fr. Irving transformed his struggling parish school into a classical academy just as we have done, and has added the high school grades just like we are doing. I will be preaching on the "work of the Holy Angels," a topic that I've been studying and teaching for many years now. Please pray for the good people in Long Beach next week, and I will have them pray for you.


