#### A question of perspective

While walking on the road out of town, I encountered three man carrying loads of bricks on their shoulders, on their way into town. As the first man approached, I greeted him and asked him what he was doing. He stopped and set down his pack, looking almost a little annoyed. "I'm carrying a load of bricks on my back! What does it look like I'm doing?!" He rolled his eyes and shook his head,

mumbling some epithets under his breath, as he re-shouldered his load and hurried on his way.

A few moments later, I met the second man. After exchanging greetings with him, I asked him what he was doing. He stopped to face me, taking a couple of deep breaths as he adjusted the load on his shoulders. "Times are tough, and I'm trying to earn enough to feed and house my family..." He apologized for rushing off, and within a minute was even beyond shouting range.

The third man approached shortly after that, and exchanged greetings with me. I asked him what he was doing. "We're building a cathedral in town. It's going to be magnificent when we've finished it!" He wished me well, and continued on his way.


