He Comes With this Sunday we have entered Advent, a word that indicates Christ's Second Coming. "Advent" literally means a "coming toward," and the subject of that gerund is Christ Himself, who has promised to return on the clouds of heaven

with legions of angels at the end of time. Today begins the new liturgical year, so happy New Year's Day (the Church is a month ahead of the government), when we pray to use well the gift of time God has given us. Every new year looks forward to the New Age, when the King will return to usher in heaven's eternal day. Many are in danger of falling into hell's eternal night on that Day of Judgment, so the first two weeks of Advent are given us to

prepare for His Second Coming, that "Day of Wrath" as the Church describes the last day of human history. This Judgment will be fearsome for all of us, when each of us will be held to account for what he did in the flesh, for good and for evil. But we hope and pray that "That Day," the dies illa, will be the day we are caught up with Christ the King into the clouds of heaven. We pray, and we work, towards His coming, His day of judgment, that we will be judged mercifully, and Christ's blood will cover our nakedness with His shining grace. You will hear frightfully apocalyptic scriptures at Mass over the next two weeks, so let's take them seriously and prepare for

Christmas not just with drinking, eating, and shopping, but with prayer and penance and works of charity.

**Our Advent Guadalupe** In six years it will have been half a millennium since Our Lady appeared in the New World to the pure and humble Mexica Indian, St. Juan Diego.

December 9, 1531, began four apparitions to the 57-year-old widower as he ran to his parish church for the Mass of the Immaculate Conception. Then she appeared in front of him, clothed with the sun: "Juanito, Juan Dieguito!" She called out. "My little one, Juanito, the smallest of my sons, where are you going?" Juan replied: "My Lady, my Queen, littlest of my daughters, I am going to your house in Tlatilolco, to follow the things of God."

> And she asked him to build a chapel on that very hill, Tepeyac, where they stood: "Know for certain, my son, my littlest one, that I am the perfect and ever virgin holy Mary, mother of the true God, through whom all things live... I ardently desire that they build me here my sacred house, where I will show Him, I will exalt Him and make Him manifest. I will offer Him to all the people with all

my love, because I am truly your merciful mother, yours and mother of all who live together in this land." And so Juan did build a chapel there, which is still at the bottom of the hill in Mexico City, 494 years later.

**She Comes This Tuesday** Archbishop Cordileone is preparing even now for the 500th anniversary of Guadalupe. He has obtained a full-sized replica of Juan Diego's tilma, touched it to the original in Mexico city, and sent it around the Archdiocese for nine days of prayer. On December 2, the relic-tilma will spend a day at Star of the Sea in our sanctuary. The full schedule is on the back of this bulletin, and I encourage you to come to one

> of the three Masses that day and pray one of the four rosaries (one for each apparition) this Tuesday. You will be receiving my parish Christmas card in the mail soon with the full schedule of Advent and Christmas events. A blessed Advent to you all! Fr. Joseph

**37-44) A Day** You Do Not Expect Our Lord's words "Stay Awake!" open Advent and the New Liturgical Year. As in the days of Noah, when the flood rushed upon the people, carrying them all away to death, so it will be when the Son of Man returns, He says. "You must be prepared," for at an hour you do not expect, He will come. How to prepare? Monthly Confession, weekly Mass, and daily rosary. Bake those practices into your life this year, and you will be ready when He comes.



#### **EUCHARISTIC ADORATION**

The Feast of St Andrew is November 30th. He was the older brother of St. Peter. He is known as "Protokletos" because he was the first disciple to follow Jesus. He was martyred on a x-formed cross because he didn't feel worthy of dying the same way as Christ did.

**St. Andrew Christmas Novena.** Pray 15 times daily from Nov 30-Dec 24 for a special intention: *Hail and blessed be the hour and moment in which the Son of God was born of the most pure Virgin Mary, at midnight, in Bethlehem, in the piercing cold. In that hour vouchsafe, I beseech Thee, O my God, to hear my prayer and grant my desires through the merits of Our Savior Jesus Christ, and of His blessed Mother. Amen. Guadalupe: The Miracle and the Message The most important event in the evangelization of the New World occurred in December, 1531. Over the course of four days, the Virgin Mary, under the title of Our Lady of Guadalupe, appeared to an indigenous convert named Juan Diego. As a result of this encounter, and the image miraculously imprinted on Juan Diego's tilma (cloak), nine million Native Americans embraced the Catholic faith, and the Americas began its transformation into the Catholic hemisphere. Our Lady of Guadalupe's message of love had replaced the institutionalized violence of the Aztec culture and built a bridge between two worlds. Guadalupe: The Miracle and the Message traces the history of this transformative event from the 16th century to the present. Narrated by Jim Caviezel.




