August 3, 2025 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Red Missal: pg 516); 8th Sunday After Pentecost (1962 Missal: pg 743)



Today's gospel begins on a curious note: *Someone in the crowd said to Jesus, "Teacher, tell my brother to share the inheritance with me."* Sounds like an echo of the gospel two Sundays ago, (Luke 10:38-42), when Martha went to Jesus and said, "Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me by

myself to do the serving? Tell her to help me." In both cases we see that people looked upon Jesus as one with such great authority that he could be even asked to solve domestic squabbles. And in both cases, Jesus uses the opportunity to teach about the Kingdom of God. Jesus warns us against greed and that life is more than possessions. And then Jesus uses a story about a man who amasses great wealth only to die before he could enjoy his money. The man in the gospel had so much, he tore down his barns to build bigger ones. What would have been a better use of his excess wealth? Having wealth in his case did not lead to happiness in this life, and certainly did not prepare him for the life to come.

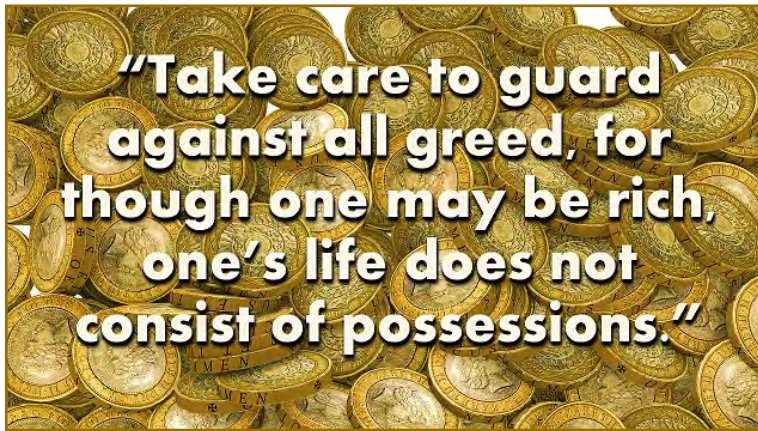
I knew a man from Hong Kong who was very wealthy. A Catholic and billionaire. He had so much money he bought a mansion owned by Senator Ted Kennedy on the Potomac River in Virginia across from Washington, DC for \$6 million, paying above the value of the house, some 14 years ago. When he realized that the house was not worth what he paid for it, he decided to tear it down and construct a French-style chateau on the property for \$45 million. I met him when he came

to Mass one day when he was visiting Macau where I lived and taught at the time and he invited me to a meal after the Sunday evening Mass. At first, I declined his invitation, not knowing who he was, but more importantly I had classes to teach the next day, Monday morning. He said to me, "Father, everyone has to eat." So I accepted his invitation. Over dinner, he told me the sad story of his life of wealth. Rather than producing happiness it divided his family. He was well in his 80s when I met him and two of his sons were not happy that their father was living so long—they wanted their share of the inheritance now, so they took him to court to demeaned that a judge give them their share of their father's wealth even before he died. So he rewrote his will to exclude his greedy sons. How different than the father in the parable of the Prodigal Son, who faced a similar fate but waited patiently for his son's conversion; also not like the son in the same parable, who eventually was reconciled with his father. In this case, both the wealthy man from Hong Kong and his sons ended up being bitter with each other. Instead of money bringing some kind of happiness, it brought

division and discord in the family, like the opening words of the gospel today when a man asked Jesus to tell his brother to share the inheritance with him. Excess wealth can do strange things to people. Life has to mean more than money

and possessions. There must be a basic goodness and joy to life that does not depend on money. For we all know, possessions are useful but they cannot bring us happiness. Jesus did not rely on things to make him happy. For us, relying on Jesus and not money produces the greatest happiness.

The Sunday Scriptures

Unless we have a clear idea and commitment to what is important in life, really important, we will focus our efforts on money and the desires and attractions around us in the world. St. Paul reminds us what is most important: to seek what is above, that is Christ.

We celebrate St. Dominic de Guzman on August 4 (trad) and August 8 (Roman). He was born into nobility and after studying theology, he joined the Benedictines. Eventually, after speaking against heresy, he formed a more austere order, which Pope Honorius III named "Order of Preachers" (OP).

He was given the rosary and had a devotion to the Blessed Sacrament saying "Arm yourself with prayer, instead of a sword..."
